



Bank of Maharashtra distributes smart cards under IT-enabled financial inclusion plan

Bank of Maharashtra has drawn up a road map to provide banking services to 1215 villages having population of over 2000 through ICT-based business correspondence Model. All these villages will be covered by March 2012.

Shri A.S. Bhattacharya Chairman& Managing Director of Bank of Maharashtra visited *Wadegavhan* village in Ahmednagar District in Maharashtra on 2nd February 2011 to oversee the implementation of Financial Inclusion Plan. He inspected the enrollment process, transactions through POS machine, and interacted with customer service providers, customers, farmers and impressed upon them to avail banking services at their doorstep. He has further stated that the bank will be issuing pass books in addition to smart cards for cross verification entries in the banking system. He has also distributed Smart Cards and Kisan Credit Cards to farmers in villages.
