## MP High Court confirms death sentence of child rapist

**JABALPUR**

The Madhya Pradesh High Court on Friday confirmed the death sentence awarded to a schoolteacher for raping a four-year-old girl in Satna district.

Confirming the death penalty of the convict, Mahendra Singh Gond, a division bench of justices P K Jaiswal and Anjali Palo said the court should impose a punishment befitting the crime. Gond, a schoolteacher, was convicted and sentenced to death by a trial court in Satna district in September last year, government advocate Brahmadatt Singh said.

The convict had appealed against the trial court judgment in the high court. The bench observed, "In the present scenario, where such crimes are continuously increasing, reformative ideas are totally ineffective.

"Justice demands that the court should impose a punishment befitting the crime so that it reflects the public abhorrence of the crime." It further said, "It could not be conceived from a person, who is performing the pious duty of a teacher, who is expected to nurture the character and morality in the children of the nation, to commit such kind of a heinous act which is tantamount to moral turpitude."

The trial court had sentenced Gond to death under the recently-introduced section 376(a)(b) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). The convict was also found guilty under IPC section 363 (kidnapping), for which he was sentenced to seven years of rigorous imprisonment, besides being fined Rs 5,000, Singh said.

The incident had occurred on July 1, 2018 in Parasmaniya village when the convict had gone to meet the father of the girl, he added. Finding the girl sleeping alone in the courtyard of her house at night, he had taken her to a nearby field and raped her, the government advocate said.

The girl was found in an unconscious state by her parents near the field the next morning, the counsel said. Subsequently, the father of the girl had lodged an FIR with the local police and Gond was arrested, he added.

## CM likely to launch Yuva Rozgar Yojna on R-Day

Chief Minister Kamal Nath is expected to announce his ambitious Yuva Rozgar Yojna (Youth Employment Scheme) on Republic Day.

The Rozgar Yojna is set on pattern of MGNREGA - meant for urban youth only. The unemployed youth will be given employment for at least 100 days in a year. This is considered to be an important stroke by Nath in attracting youth for Lok Sabha elections.

First the youth will be trained in a factory, where the candidate will get some money as well. After training, candidates will get job in the same company on mentioned pay. If a candidate after completing training wants to start a venture of his own, he will be provided assistance from the state government.

Nath had been stressing regularly on the need to grow employment opportunities.

Before going to Davos, Nath had said that he will explore all the opportunities to increase employment in state.

He also said that he will be disclosing some plans and schemes very soon - to improve employment opportunities in the state.

Congress had stressed on employment in its vachan-patra of assembly elections. It had also promised an allowance of Rs 4000 to the unemployed.

## FARM LOAN WAIVER FIR to be filed against those guilty of irregularities

Nath back after 7 day Davos tour

Chief Minister Kamal Nath reached Chhindwara on Friday after coming back from his 7-day Davos tour.

He would arrive in the state capital on Saturday after hoisting the national flag in Chhindwara on the Republic Day.

Nath, interacting with journalists in Chhindwara, said first information reports (FIRs) will be lodged against those found guilty of irregularities in farm loans from cooperative banks. Nath said Shivraj Singh Chouhan does not remember slum dwellers but the power of his position.

## Slaughterhouse to be shifted

RULES GOVERNING OPERATION WILL BE AMENDED

The slaughterhouse in the city will now be shifted to a new area. The national green tribunal (NGT) had recently remanded the civic body on the issue.

The rules governing the operation of the new slaughterhouse will also undergo amendment.

In the Bhopal Municipal Council meet at ISBT, the corporators raised their objection on the slaughterhouse terming it to be the market of meat, said that the slaughterhouse will be harmful for the nature.

The congress corporators had already boycotted the

council meet and only 49 corporators from ruling BJP and Mayor Alok Sharma were in the house when chairman announced the shifting.

**Separate DPR for abattoir**

Chairperson Surjeet Singh Chouhan announced that the slaughterhouse has to be built in new form with new DPR and that the amount of meat which will be slaughtered there would have to be supplied only within the city and the export of meat from the city's slaughterhouse will not be allowed.

**Residents of Adampur stage protest**

A group of people from Adampur staged a protest against their area to be used for abattoir. They were saying that their land has a temple and that the slaughterhouse will be an affront to their faith hence they will not allow the civic body for it.
