11-year-old boy, his rescuer drown in Anantapur

An 11-year-old boy and a 25-year-old man drowned in a village pond near Kundurpi mandal headquarters on Wednesday. Kalyanadurgam police said that the class 6 student, Vishnu, while returning home with his friends after school, accidentally fell into the pond. A local passerby Kansala Naveen, who attempted to rescue the boy, drowned along with him. Kalyanadurgam MLA Amilineni Surendra Babu assured government support to the families of the two deceased. Police shifted the bodies to an area hospital for autopsy. A case has been registered.

One more worker injured in cement factory mishap dies

A worker, Banavath Swamy Naik, 28, who suffered severe burns in the accident at the UltraTech Cement Factory in Jaggalahpet mandal of NTR district died while undergoing treatment on Wednesday. The toll in the accident now rose to two, while 14 others injured in the accident are hospitalised in Vijayawada. The accident occurred on the third floor of the plant on July 7.

APUTF urges Lokesh to address issues of education sector

It cites various qualms such as GO IIT on merger of schools, delay in academic calendar, and non-uniformity in introduction of CBSE syllabus

Members of the Andhra Pradesh United Teachers' Federation (APUTF) have urged Minister for Human Resource Development (HRD) Nara Lokesh to "intervene and set right the series of wrongs committed by the previous YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) in the education sector."

At a press conference here on Wednesday, federation's State President N. Venkateswarlu and general secretary K.S.S. Prasad said the education needed immediate intervention.

Finding fault with GO IIT on merger of schools, they said the 4,457 primary schools where Classes 3, 4 and 5 were merged with either upper primary or high schools, were left with just Classes 1 and 2 and had not witnessed a single admission during this academic year. Last year, more than 12,000 schools functioned with mere one teacher and in the current academic year, the student strength had not crossed 10 to 15 in 20,000 schools, they said.

They said that the government announcing that under "Thalikalika Vandanam" scheme, every school-age child in the State would be provided an annual payment of ₹15,000, private schools, even those who did not have recognition, were resorting to luring tactics to attract students from the government schools to their institutions.

The School Education Department had not released the academic calendar even after a month of the reopening of schools in the State, and there was no clarity if students of Class 10 would be asked to write their exams only in English medium, or would be allowed to write in Telugu medium as was assured to them earlier.

Stating that introduction of the CBSE syllabus in selected schools had not benefited anyone, they said there was no scope for a new admission in Class 10 in schools that were following the Central syllabus, while at the same time, a large number of students who passed out of Class 9 were opting out of schools to avoid the Central syllabus.

The leaders urged the government to implement a uniform syllabus in schools across the State.

Teachers' issues They said the teachers' expectations that they would be rid of non-teaching duties after the formation of the new government were dashed as these works had been increasing by the day.

Citing growing dissent among teachers, they said during the admissions time, teachers were kept away from schools to make them attend a nine-day long training session on "teaching tools". Representing the case of municipal teachers, they said though they were brought under the School Education Department two years back, the upgrade of their posts, transfers, promotions and other issues were not yet addressed.

presenting the YSRCP. He called for the reconstruction of the three-decade-old Underground Drainage System (UDS) development of internal roads and hassle-free supply of drinking water across the city. He also sought a fact-finding committee to probe the TDR bonds' scam."
