

Morni to get ₹20cr micro-irrigation project

Chandigarh: To provide better irrigation facilities to the farmers of the hilly Morni area of Panchkula district, the Haryana government on Monday decided to set up a major micro-irrigation project there. The project would come up at a cost of Rs 20 crore

and is expected to cover approximately 1,280 acres. A decision to this effect was taken in the High Powered Purchase Committee (HPPC) meeting held here under the chairmanship of CM Manohar Lal Khattar. Besides, purchases and contracts of more than Rs 87 crore were also approved at the meeting.

The CM said the implementation of the Solar Powered Integrated Micro Irrigation Project for Tapariya, Kandawala, Kaimbwala, Kherwali Parwala and Lashkariwala villages in Morni will not only provide irrigation facilities but also help increasing agriculture produce. After the success of the pilot project, other similar projects will be set up at other places in the state, he said.

In the meeting, the project for the revival of Indo-

river from Bass Padamkato Siwari in Gurugram was also approved. Approval was also accorded to a project of the irrigation department. Under this, V R bridges on the Lakhan Majra link drain will be reconstructed.

In the meeting, along with the construction of two intermediate pumping stations in Adampur, the project for setting up a sewerage network system was also approved.

The project will cost about Rs 34.5 crore.

'Harassed' by loan sharks, 2 men die by suicide in Jind

SHOs To Keep Tabs On Financiers

Jind: Two men died by suicide in Jind in the last two days after allegedly being harassed by financiers, police said on Monday.

The kin of Satish Kumar, 36, from Indira Colony and Satish Sahgal, 48, of Jind City's Jain Nagar area, alleged that both were beaten up by money lenders, which forced them to take the extreme step.

Satish Kumar, who is survived by wife, son and two daughters, used to repair gas stoves. His relatives claimed that he had returned most of the loan amount along with interest and only Rs 1,200 was pending.

"Financier Pawan Kumar and his father doubled the principal amount of Rs 10,000 in two months, increased the interest rate and later sought Rs 70,000 from Satish Kumar. Still, all the money was paid back and a meagre amount was pending, but they still roughed him up and forced him to transfer his bike in their name as well," said one of the victim's relatives.

The family of Satish Sahgal, who was a rag picker, blocked the road leading to BJP MLA Krishan Middha's

Liquor contractor shot dead in Hisar village, several booked

Hisar: A liquor contractor was shot dead in a hotel situated in Bhimewala village of Uklana area of Hisar on Sunday. Victim Balwan was a resident of Julehra village in Jind. The police have started an investigation after registering a case on the complaint of Kamlesh against against Balsher Singh, former sarpanch of Bithmara, Surendra, liquor contractor of Bhimewala village; his associates Manoj and Pradeep, both residents of Julehra village; and they used to suspect that her husband Balwan Singh brought liquor from outside and sold it at the hotel, she said.

"Due to this enmity, all accused came to the hotel on Sunday morning and as soon as they arrived, they started quarrelling with her husband and also threatened him. So, Surendra and his two companions shot at her husband, who fell down on the spot. Eye-witnesses of this incident are Manoj and Pradeep, both residents of Daulatpur village," she said.

In her complaint to the police, Kamlesh said Balwan was her second husband. Her first marriage was with one Sunil, a resident of Julehra village, and from this marriage she had a son and a daughter. Sunil died of a heart attack 10 months ago. After this, about 7-8 months ago, her family got her married to Sunil's elder brother Balwan Singh, and now she was about three months pregnant, she added.

Canada gangster link to liquor shop shooting that left 1 dead

Gurgaon: An Indian gangster now based in Canada ordered the liquor shop shooting last week that led to the death of one person and injured two others, police said on Monday.

A 21-year-old man from Ghaziabad was arrested for the shooting outside the shop in Pachgaon. Rohit Gadaria, however, was not among the two shooters who opened fire, but was driving the getaway bike. The shooters fired around 19 rounds in the air, police said. A probe revealed that the two gunmen, hired by gangster Lipin Nehra, wanted to intimidate the owner of Discovery Wine Shop by firing in the air.

One of the bullets, according to cops, ricocheted off the wall and hit Sandeep Kumar, a resident of UP's Saharanpur, in the chest.

Nehra, police said, is connected to Goldy Brar, a close associate of gangster Law-

rence Bishnoi. The shooters had allegedly conducted reces of the area for three days before Friday's shooting. Nehra is currently operating from Canada and left the country in 2021 on a student visa. "We arrested Rohit Gadaria on Sunday. He has no previous crime record. Gadaria drove the bike on which the two shooters escaped. He was produced in court on Monday and sent to three days' police remand," DCP (crime) Vijay Pratap said. "Nehra wanted his father to get the licence of the

Air travel from Hisar to start soon: Dushyant

Chandigarh: Haryana deputy CM Dushyant Chautala said on Monday that Gurgaon heliport was an ambitious project, which will be started soon. Under the central government's 'Udaan' scheme, air travel will start from Hisar airport soon.

The deputy CM, who also holds the civil aviation portfolio, was presiding over a meeting of senior officers of the department here. He discussed the various sites suggested by the officers related to Gurugram heliport and directed them to prepare its final report at the earliest. Referring routes from Hisar, he asked them to explore the possibility of starting flights from Hisar to Delhi, Chandigarh, Dehradun, Gorakhpur, Jaipur, Amritsar, Kullu, Jammu and other cities. Dushyant said under the scheme, 220 destinations (airports/heliports/water aerodromes) would be built for 1,000 routes by 2026.

In Sirsa, Shah killed 2 birds with one stone

Chandigarh: By addressing the BJP rally in Sirsa on Sunday, Union home minister Amit Shah has killed two birds with one stone. He expressed solidarity with Haryana minister Ranjit Singh Chautala, who is an independent MLA, and also hinted at contesting all 10 teams during 2024 Lok Sabha elections in the state, leaving BJP's alliance partner Jannayak Janata Party (JJP) in the lurch.

Ranjit (78) is the grandfather of Haryana deputy CM Dushyant Chautala. At the time when the BJP chose to keep the JJP and its leader away from the rally, it was Shah who gave priority treatment to Ranjit Singh by visiting his residence and bringing him clo-

se on the stage and asking him to address the rally ahead of CM Manohar Lal Khattar.

In his address, while lauding the role of Chaudhary Devi Lal, father of Om Parkash Chautala and Ranjit, Shah, who formally put the party in the election mode for general elections, asked people to give all 10 Lok Sabha to the BJP.

This was for the second time when Shah had requested people of Haryana to vote for the BJP in all 10 seats. He had said the same at a rally in Gohana on January 29 this year. And, the BJP had been looking for somebody better than JJP or INLD to improve the vote bank in Sirsa, Hisar and Fatehabad areas.

"I had been giving unconditional support to the BJP go-

vernment led by Manohar Lal Khattar since Day 1. It is my good luck that the BJP is relying upon me and giving me various responsibilities. Being an Independent MLA and minister, I cannot join the BJP at this stage. But I am always there when it comes to assignments," said Ranjit.

"Chaudhary Devi Lal's vote bank has been shuffling between Abhay and Ajay's parties. Now, the people have realized the situation and are with us in the name of Chaudhary Devi Lal," he added. Ranjit ruled out shifting loyalty towards the Congress due to his relations with former CM Bhupinder Hooda. "He is my school time classmate, but our political loyalties are different and I have left the Congress forever," he added.

Besides Ranjit, it was Aditya Devi Lal Chautala, who jumped in the BJP fold and is now president of BJP's Sirsa district unit.

While the BJP had won 10 Lok Sabha seats in 2019 polls, now they have nine MPs after Ambala MP Ratan Lal Kataria passed away last month. While in the assembly, the BJP has 41 MLAs and is in alliance with Dushyant-led JJP that has 10 MLAs, besides Gopal Kanda (Haryana Lokhit Party), six Independent MLAs, including Ranjit, are supporting the BJP.

In the opposition, the Congress has 30 MLAs, one MLA from INLD and Independent MLA Balraj Kundu too is in opposition of the BJP government in the 90-member assembly.
